

CSM (R) William Lake Awarded ENCOM Association “Person of the Year Award”

At the 5 November 2011 ENCOM Association Annual Meeting CSM(R) Bill Lake was presented with 2011 ENCOM Association’s Person of the Year Award. Bill is the sixth individual to be a recipient of the award. He has been a member of the Association since October 2003 when he was first appointed as “Keeper of the Coins” by then Board President COL (R) William Hawes. In July of 2004, Bill agreed to become President Elect. He then was elected as President of the Association during the October 2005 Annual Meeting. During his term in office he created, what is now, the Association’s Internet website. Since its launching Bill has continued to maintain the website with current information on activities, meeting minutes, and items of interest to the membership. Later in his term he developed the procedures and capabilities for the Board to conduct meetings via a telephone conferencing arrangement. Bill continued his contributions to the Board as the Past President in November of 2007. In the position Bill introduced the idea for the Association to assist in the TEC’s Soldier of the Year recognition which has continued to-date. He also assumed the position of Editor of the Association’s newsletter and has coordinated its collection of articles and publication.

Bill’s innovative ideas, energy, technical abilities, and steady participation have significantly contributed to an improved and involved 416th ENCOM Association. The Association congratulates Bill on his achievements.
